Please help us by collecting the following:

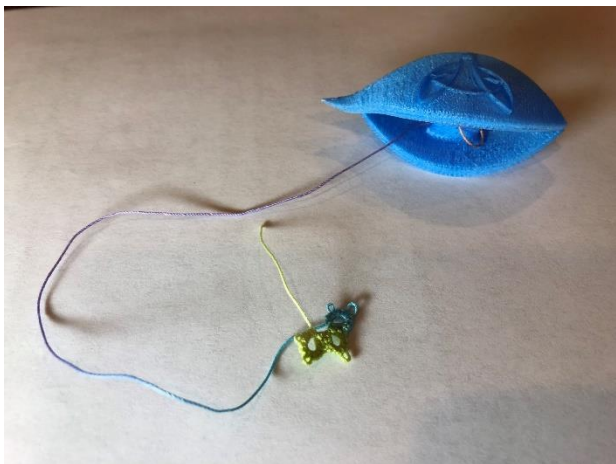
- Glass jars with lids and bottles with corks.

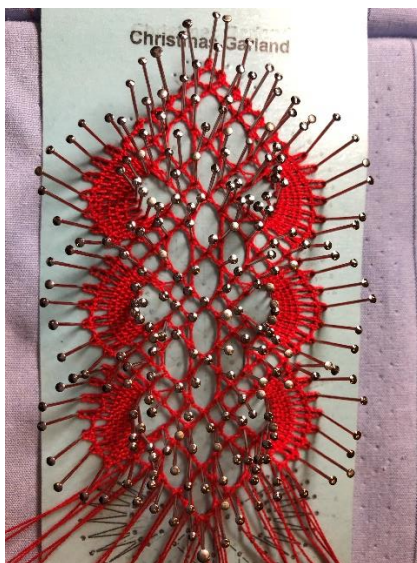
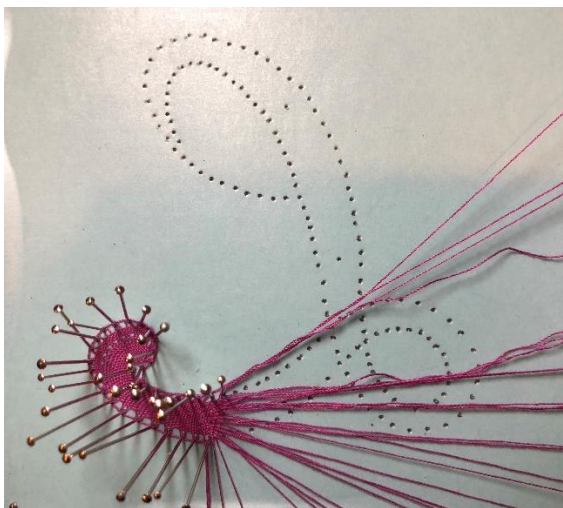
In February we will:

March Meeting:

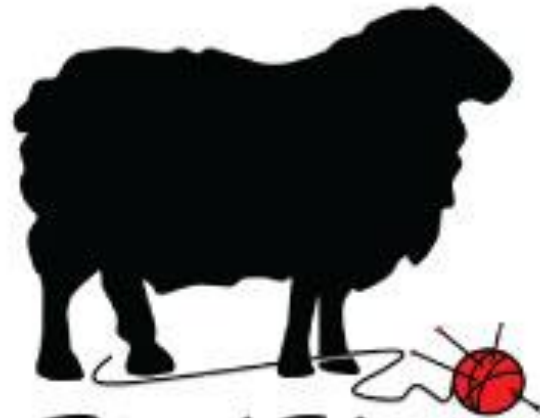
