 December 11 ~~Milanes giraffe #3~~ Schneeberger – Christmas Rose

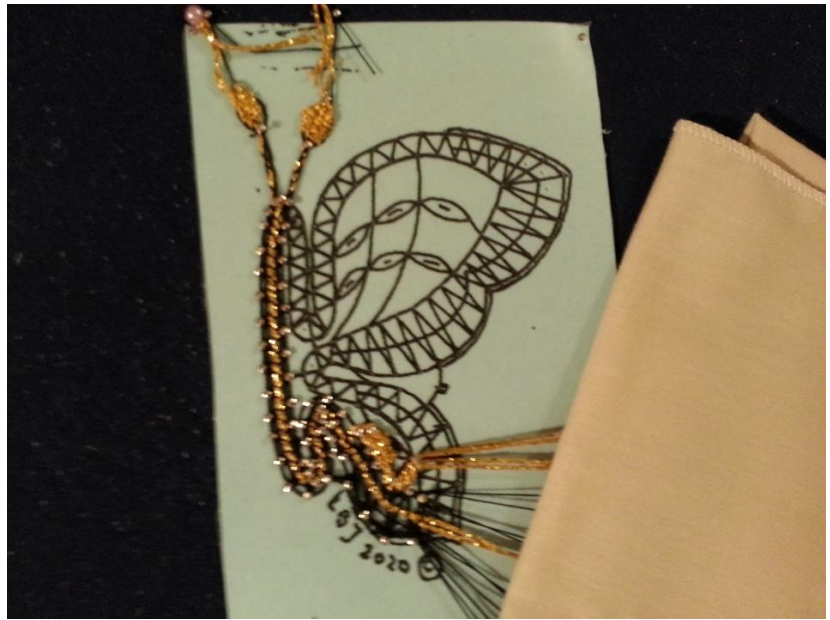
In January we will continue with Schneeberger patterns and plan the programs for 2022.

Schneeberger Continued

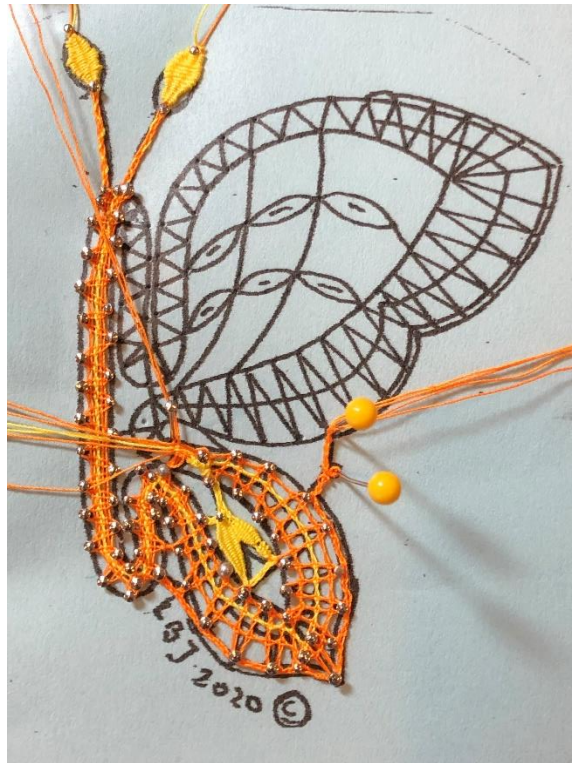

It is also one of Lia's patterns. If you make two roses, and then place one on top of the other shifting the top one, it makes a lovely two dimensional flower that looks similar to a poinsettia.
