# Koon Collection:

The laces in the Eunice Sein Koon Collection were given to I.O.L.I. in 2002. The collection includes a wide variety of bobbin, needle, tambour, and tatted laces. Dr. Jo Ann Eurell is currently re-photographing all of the pieces of lace in this collection to obtain better color for the images. As these new images become available, they will be replacing current images already on the IOLI web site, or they will be added to the images already there. Each image can be enlarged by moving the roller on your mouse without the image becoming hazy as it is enlarged. You can see the details and how the threads were manipulated. Information on “The Doily Free Zone” was highlighted in the winter 2021 issue of the IOLI Bulletin on pages 9-13. 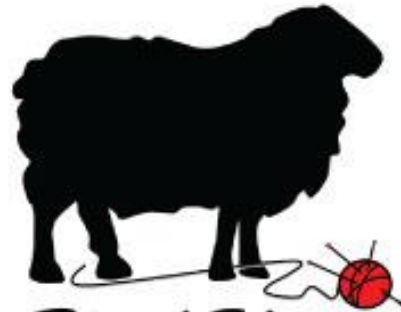


## Location for our Meetings:
